Ms. Paxton adopted ELVIS from Small Wonders Rescue L.A. in 2004. Shortly thereafter, she started her business making funky tees from vintage clothing, for 8 year old, ELVIS. Today, Chi WOW WOW sells its streetwear in almost every major city around the world.

“I really wanted to find a way to give back to the community,” said Ms. Paxton. “There are so many dedicated people trying to find humane ways to control dog and cat over-population. These organizations survive only on the funding that comes from caring individuals and businesses.”
